

The Mere and Oliver's Mount Masterplan Feasibility Study,

Addenda 1.

Scarborough Borough Council wish to clarify the following inaccuracies in the above named feasibility study report.

- 1). The report states in a number of instances that Auto 66 club hold "race events 6 days per year" on the Oliver's Mount race circuit.

In actual fact there were more than 6 days of racing permitted at the mount in 2008. The schedule for the 2008 season consisted of 7 events (both motorcycle racing and hill climbs) over a total of 12 days with a combination of full and part road closures.

It should be noted that all race events and subsequent road closures are approved in advance with the Council's Tourism and Leisure Services.

2. Paragraph 10.38. States "The organisation (Auto 66) are currently looking into a number of proposals to increase year round use of the site, and are currently in the process of applying for planning permission to extend event days to 14 days of the year"

It should be noted that any increase in the number of days will be subject to agreement with the Council's Tourism and Leisure Services and not "planning services".
