North Bay Railway wins second major award

Scarborough's North Bay Railway Company has won a prestigious award, celebrating their achievements in re-invigorating the historic railway.

The latest accolade follows their success with an important tourism award at the end of last year.

Lesley Humphreys, Managing Director of the North Bay Railway Group said:

"It's only two years since we took over the railway and to receive this sort of recognition is a tremendous achievement for everyone involved in running the railway, the Glass House Café Bistro and the other attractions here."

The latest award comes from the influential Heritage Railway Association who presented the railway with a special Certificate of Commendation at a ceremony in Wolverhampton. The H.R.A.'s citation praised the NBR "for its achievement in re-invigorating a 78 year old railway and turning it into an all-round visitor attraction."

Last year the new Glass House Café Bistro won the Yorkshire Moors and Coast Tourism Award for the Best Continental Bar of the Year.

Lesley added:

"We have lots more plans for the site and we hope that people, both locals and visitors, will continue to support us. We want to ensure we can preserve the railway and water chute for future generations to enjoy."

The railway is open every weekend of the year and for the February half-term holiday from 14 to 22 February and then daily from 4 April 2009.
