

# WELCOME TO SCARBOROUGH HARBOUR

This is a general guide to visitors to Scarborough Harbour to assist in making your stay as pleasurable as possible.

Scarborough Harbour is situated on the North East Coast of Yorkshire. The harbour consists of three piers enclosing an outer and inner harbour. It is a tidal harbour, which means that at low water on mean low water springs the harbour is figuratively dry.

On approach to Scarborough Harbour call Scarborough Harbour on VHF CH12 with berthing requirements and E.T.A.

On Harbour Masters notification and approval permission may be given to large deep drafted vessels unable to take the bottom to berth afloat in the commercial inner harbour or alongside the newly provided pontoon berths.

A tide gauge reading is available from the Port Control Office prior to entrance or departing the harbour.

Registration following arrival is obligatory and forms are available from the Port Control Office or Lighthouse during season. The maximum length of visit is 14 days.

## **Visitors Berths**

These are located in the outer harbour and alongside the newly provided pontoons in the inner harbour.

## **Port Control Office**

This is situated on the end of the West Pier it is manned 24 hours and can be contacted on Channel 12 or Tel No 01723 373877.

## **Inner Harbour Pontoon Access Gate**

The gate fitted to the link-span is operated by a security card and a deposit will be required to be paid at the Lighthouse/Port Control Office. Please be careful not to get locked out.

## **Access**

If you are registered disabled and have any special requirements concerning berthing please notify the Harbour Office, Lighthouse or Port Control.

## **Amenities**

Showers are available in the lighthouse building, with Washing – Drying Machines. Keys to toilets and washroom available from the Lighthouse Attendant during the summer months. Please return when finished. Showers are money operated.

## **Water & Electricity**

Please contact the Lighthouse Attendant or Port Control.

## **Refuse**

Domestic refuse can be placed in the bin near the steps to Pontoon berths marked L/H.

**Waste Oil**

Container is located on the West Pier please contact harbour staff if you need assistance.

**Mooring**

Please ensure that your craft is properly secured with bow, stern lines and springs adequate to requirements.

**Slipway**

This is located on Sandside and the keys are available from the Lighthouse during the summer season or Port Control.

**Car Parking**

There is the Marine Drive and three Public car parks in the vicinity of Scarborough Harbour.

**Weather Forecasts**

These can be obtained from Port Control or during the season from the Lighthouse Attendant.

**Safety & Security**

Please take note of the safety equipment provided and its location.

A 24-hour watch keeping system employing CCTV surveillance is operated by the Harbour Authority for safety and security purposes

**Speed**

All craft to maintain a slow speed within Harbour Limits.

**Pets**

Please keep these on a lead and do not let them foul the pontoons or footpaths.

**Supplies**

Diesel oil, petrol and chandlery are available locally. Details from Port Control or Lighthouse Attendant.
