Notice to Mariners

Navigable Depths

16 June 2016

All Mariners are advised that the navigable depth of water between the pier extensions and in the upper harbour main channel adjacent to the East and West pontoons, has reduced due to siltation.

However water depths in these areas, as published on Admiralty Charts, are still applicable and all mariners should passage plan and execute their voyage accordingly.

The affected areas will be dredged at the earliest opportunity and this LNtM shall remain in force until corrective works have been undertaken.
