3.1 JH gave a presentation on the final draft Scarborough TIP;

MG requested a piece of work is undertaken around the revenue requirements for the projects to ensure sustainability and look to identify potential funding streams.

- 3.2 BM ran through the key components of the Scarborough Masterplan;
- Statement of ambition – 7 key objectives
  - Cord of activity from the Station down to the Harbour focussing on different areas of activity within the town centre
  - Explored coast and parkland encompassing the wider area of Scarborough
  - South Scarborough
  - North Scarborough
  - Scarborough wide initiatives – more than place based
- 3.3 AR has arranged another Check & Challenge session between Aecom and Arup on the 7<sup>th</sup> October to give the TIP one last check over before submission to MHCLG at the end of October.
