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EXPLANATORY NOTES REGARDING SCARBOROUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL'S CEMETERIES

The following notes are the important points in the Rules and Regulations covering Scarborough Borough Council's meadow burial sites and should be noted before applying for an interment in one of these areas operated by Scarborough Borough Council. Your Funeral Director will ask you to read the notes carefully and sign this form to confirm that you have read and understood them. *A copy of this form is included for your retention.*

A full copy of the Rules and Regulations relating to Scarborough Borough Council's Cemeteries will be enclosed with the documents sent to you following the interment.

Meadow Burial Rules and Regulations

- **No** memorial headstones are allowed in the Meadow area
- There can be **No** permanent memorials left on any grave, cut flowers will be accepted without any plastic wrapping
- **No** planting of any type is allowed within the Meadow area
- **No** Maintenance of graves is allowed by the public, this includes strimming and cutting etc.
- Any unauthorised items, i.e. bird boxes, wind chimes etc will be removed immediately.

This list is not exhaustive and the Superintendent of Scarborough Cemeteries may add or change items as required

The people laid to rest in this area wanted to be in a more natural surrounding and we ask families and friends to respect their wishes and abide by the rules of the Meadow area.

I have received a copy of the enclosed notes and confirm that having read and understood them I will comply with all requirements stated therein and with all current and future Rules and Regulations.

I sign this document on the understanding that any contravention of the Rules and Regulations of Scarborough Borough Council cemeteries will result in the immediate removal of the offending items placed on or planted in the grave area.
