**NOTICE TO THE CHAIR OF THE OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEE OF A GENERAL EXCEPTION TO THE  
PUBLICATION OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE A KEY DECISION**

1. Where a decision maker intends to make a key decision<sup>1</sup> that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given<sup>2</sup>.
2. Where the publication of the intention to make a key decision is impracticable, that decision can only be made where the Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been informed by notice in writing; that notice has been made available for inspection by the public at the authority's offices and upon their website (if they have one); and after 5 clear days have elapsed following the day on which the notice was made publicly available<sup>3</sup>.

3. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** to the Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee that it has been impracticable to give 28 clear days public notice of the items set out in the table below for the reasons given therein, and that it is intended that key decisions will be made on the date specified.
4. **NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN** to the public of the reasons why compliance with the requirements for publicity in connection with key decisions has been impracticable.
