### LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

## Harbours, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847

### Eskside Wharf Restrictions

**02 August 2022**

All Mariners are advised that LNtM 2017:03 has been rescinded and is superseded by this notice LNtM 2022:04.

Following a recent inspection of the sheet piling on Eskside Wharf, mariners are advised that the mooring of any vessels within the vicinity of the sheet piled wall **is now prohibited**.

Additionally, vessels passing or operating in the vicinity of Eskside Wharf must do so at slow speed and maintain a minimum distance of 15m from the sheet piled wall which includes the dry dock.

Vessels berthed alongside Eskside Wharf at the time of this LNtMs issue, should vacate the area as soon as their disposition enables them to do so.

Mariners are advised that this measure is in force in the interests of the safety of vessels and personnel following the advice of engineers and will be withdrawn or modified at the earliest safe opportunity to do so.

This notice shall remain in force until further notice.
