

Scarborough Leisure Village

Since 2007, the Council has been investigating the possibility of delivering a new high-quality, multi-purpose leisure village for Scarborough. The key drivers of this process were to deliver:

- A new community stadium to bring Scarborough Athletic Football Club home; and
- A new, state-of-the-art health and fitness centre to replace the existing aging facilities in the town.

The former Weaponness Park and Ride facility has been identified and chosen as the most suitable site to accommodate this new leisure village.

Our proposal

Building upon this initial work, the Council has now chosen Wrenbridge as its development partner to deliver this exciting and much-needed new leisure village. We intend to submit a planning application shortly, but before we do, we want to find out what you think about the proposals.

The new leisure village on the disused park and ride facility will include:

- A new 2,000 capacity community football stadium with artificial pitch to allow for the return of Scarborough Athletic Football Club;
- 25m swimming pool and associated teaching pool;
- 4 court sports hall;
- Gym and dance studio;
- 3 x squash courts;
- Multi-use games area facility; and
- Associated accommodation and facilities.
