In accordance with [Section 18C](#) of the Representation of the People Act 1983, Scarborough Borough Council gives notice that it is conducting an interim review of polling districts and polling places for Parliamentary and Local Government Elections within the following Wards only:

Esk Valley, Northstead, Steonshalh.

The review will have regard to the unavailability and suitability of some existing designated polling places with those Wards moving forwards.

Any registered elector may make representations on the current and proposed arrangements. We welcome comments and suggestions from anyone who has expertise in access for people with any type of disability.

Where possible, people making representations should suggest alternative places that may be used as polling places.
