Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, or on the ground that a requirement of the Act or of any relevant regulation made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from 1 March 2019, make the application for the purpose to the High Court.
