In accordance with [Section 18C\(1\)](#) of the Representation of the People Act 1983, Scarborough Borough Council gives notice that it is conducting a review of all polling districts and polling places for Parliamentary and Local Government Elections.

The review will have regard to the outcome of a review of the Scarborough Borough Council electoral arrangements undertaken by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England.

Any registered elector may make representations on the current and proposed arrangements. We welcome comments and suggestions from anyone who has expertise in access for people with any type of disability.

Where possible, people making representations should suggest alternative places that may be used as polling places.
