**NOTICE OF A KEY DECISION OF A DECISION MAKING BODY TO WHICH THE CHAIR OF THE RELEVANT OVERVIEW AND  
SCRUTINY COMMITTEE HAS AGREED IS URGENT AND CANNOT REASONABLY BE DEFERRED**

1. Where a decision maker intends to make a key decision<sup>1</sup> that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given<sup>2</sup>.
2. Where the publication of the intention to make a key decision is impracticable, that decision can only be made where; the Chair of the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been informed by notice in writing; that notice has been made available for inspection by the public at the authority's offices and upon their website (if they have one); and after 5 clear days have elapsed following the day on which the notice was made publicly available<sup>3</sup>.
3. Where the date by which a key decision must be made makes compliance with paragraph 2 above impracticable, that decision can only be made where; the Chair of the relevant Overview and Scrutiny Committee (or in their absence the Chairman of the authority) has agreed that the making of the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.<sup>4</sup>
4. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that compliance with the requirements for giving notice has been impracticable in relation to the items of business detailed in the table below, and that it is intended to make key decisions about the same on the date specified.
